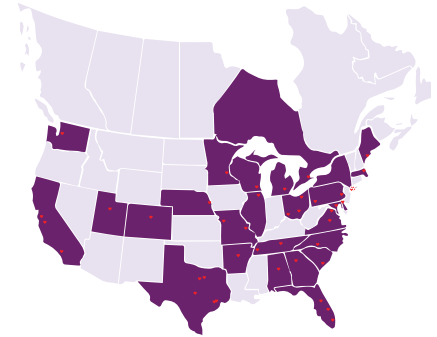


Welcome PAC³ Clinical Champions!

Clinical Champion Expectations

- ♥ Recruit members from all disciplines (nurses, APPs, physicians, dieticians, therapists, etc.) and patient families to participate in PAC³
 - One member from each center is expected to join a sub-committee, though there is no upper limit on committee participation
- ♥ Responsibility for the data
 - Timeliness of data submission
 - Access to unblinded data from member centers once criteria is met
 - Participate in regional/virtual training prior to data entry start and audit when eligible
 - Regularly scheduled meetings with data champion for timely clarification/adjudication of data fields
- ♥ Point person of contact for your center
- ♥ Advocate for appropriate data champion/team staffing
- ♥ Elevate team members to take part in and lead PAC³ projects, committees, and quality improvement work
- ♥ Attend semi-annual meetings
- ♥ Complete bi-annual hospital survey
