Hope everyone is having a great summer and staying cool. It has been a busy summer. The <u>Health Equity Module</u> is now officially in its <u>seventh month</u>! We are up to <u>28 centers</u> that have joined and <u>16 actively contributing data!!!</u> © Please know we are still here for you and available for questions. We have been aiming to continually improve your experience, and we are happy to introduce a new process map for the Health Equity module set up. Also we now have a way for you to see how much data you have contributed to the module and if there are any problems using the Health Equity status report.

The <u>Health Equity Status report</u> was created to show your center's uploaded and processed degauss files. The report details which of your degauss submissions match a submitted hospitalization or not. When degauss hospital IDs do not match submitted PAC3 hospitalizations, we ask that you investigate and correct the mismatched submissions. Some example corrections are resubmitting the degauss file using the correct hospitalization ID, or submitting the corresponding hospitalization from your vendor software.

As a reminder, data is expected to be entered into the Health Equity Module on all hospitalizations from January 3rd, 2023 going forward for H2H centers see table below.

Visualization of the data is on the way with plans to be readily available to participating centers at the end of summer ③. AS STATED AT THE CONFERNCE, ONLY CENTERS WHO HAVE SUBMITTED DATA TO THE HEALTH EQUITY MODULE BY JULY WILL HAVE IMMEDIATE ACCESS TO INITIAL VISUALIZATION.
